**Bio: Bonerama:** Unlike any other rock ‘n’ roll, funk or brass band, Bonerama brings a unique spin to vintage New Orleans funk and hits on all four cylinders in the brass section. Not quite the traditional brass band (there are no trumpets or saxes), the four-trombone frontline blows audiences away with improvised, vintage funk and classic rock riffs. *Rolling Stone* magazine praised their “...crushing ensemble riffing, human-feedback shrieks and wah-wah growls” (2007).
